Write a review (100 word min./200 word max.) of the book you read and email it to me at lagrone@knights.paragonprep.com. **Please write the review in the body of the email.** I will then post it on the Blog on this site. Each review will receive the grade it earns and will be posted regardless of quality. Sort of scary? Heck, no...I'd write something that would make me really, really proud. If, perchance, your review doesn't receive a good grade, then you and I will spend some lunch times together after school starts catching you up on writing skills and improving your grade.
